MEMORIAL SERVICE

The Sunday Multi-Faith Memorial Service will commemorate the beginning of the end of the First World War and remember those who have lost their lives on active service around the world, but particularly those airmen who died on the Highclere Estate.

The Earl and Countess of Carnarvon have dedicated a life-size memorial of an airman, carved from a 200 year old Cedar felled on the Highclere Estate, with trunk rings marked for the years 1914, 1918, 1939 and 1945.
